
Welcome! As you enter the room, please...

Group Roles

- Summarizer/Reporter Prepares and presents brief summary of group's work

Implement a Process (such as this) to Identify, Formulate, and Solve Problems

- Expect some problems, challenges, and barriers
 - Recognize problems when they appear (or before they appear)
 - With one or more colleagues, develop three or more solutions
 - Implement one, evaluate, replan, and retry
